<u> Arkansas Division Scrapbook Award</u>



Eligibility: All Camps in good standing of the Arkansas Division

<u>Selection Process:</u> Completed scrapbooks must be delivered to the Arkansas Division Commander by Friday night. The Awards Committee will determine the winner after reviewing all entries.

Required Contents: Scrapbooks must be under one cover.

Scrapbooks must include:

Cover, title page, camp roster, memorial or namesake page, and the activities section. The activities section is the main section, and may include photographs, documents, written accounts of meetings, programs, projects, work with other organizations, and reenactments. This section is restricted to portraying the activities of the camp and its members; material about the SCV in general or other contents irrelevant to camp activities should not be included.

<u>Selection Criteria:</u> Final judging will be based on compliance with Required Contents, overall organization and appearance of the scrapbook, and the coherence of the activities section (i.e., how well does this section tell the story of the camp's activities during the past year? The Time Period being Arkansas Division Reunion to Arkansas Division Reunion).

<u>Note:</u> The Arkansas Division Scrapbook does not have to include page numbers, total of 50 pages, or index like the national SCV Scrapbook Award to help reduce expense to the Camps that want to submit their SCV Camp Scrapbook to the SCV National Scrapbook competition.
